

Earning In-service credit in your district or through RID's Certificate Maintenance Program (CMP)

If you wish to earn RID CEUs you will use the PINRA (Participant Initiated Non-RID Activities) process. I have attached the PINRA form to this email.

You will need to complete the personal information and sign the form, before you return it to me. I must receive it before the module begins. I have completed the other information requested on the form and have the additional documentation (agenda and goals) necessary. Once the Module is complete I will put them with your form and certificate and forward the information to RID.

You will need to return a completed form to me before the start of the course. You can scan it and send via email or print it out and send by way of the US post office. You can earn 0.25 CEUs per week in the Professional Studies category if you satisfactorily complete all tasks, and assignments required in your Module, except the One-to-One Mentoring Module. The Mentoring modules can earn 0.4 CEUs per week. Your instructor will verify your work at the end of the module.

District In-Service Points

Those who want to earn in-service points in your District will need to contact the district personnel to request it. This module will require about 2 hours per week so credit will given accordingly. You have the course objectives on the syllabus which the county coordinator might need to determine what activity code they can use.
